CBSE REGISTRATION FOR GRADE 9

Dear Parent,

Greetings from WISE Indian Private School!

This is to inform you that the CBSE Grade 9 registration process has commenced. This is an important step as it enables the Board to plan for the Class X examination for the forthcoming year.

An essential part of registration is the accurate entry of students' and parents' personal details. Therefore, we request your cooperation in carefully completing the process as outlined below:

1. Kindly fill out the Google Registration Form with accurate details exactly as per the child's passport: <https://forms.gle/YnBTDw8Sg1MTp3yD7>
2. Submit the following documents to the class teacher:
 - a. Student's passport copy
 - b. Father's passport copy
 - c. Mother's passport copy
 - d. Aadhaar card copy (for Indian students)
 - e. Recent passport-size photograph

Deadline: All documents must be submitted to the class teacher **on or before 22nd September 2025**.

We seek your kind cooperation in completing this process without any errors.

Kindly find below the guidelines for taking passport-size photographs:

- The photograph should be taken in a professional studio.
- Do not take photographs using mobile phones.
- CBSE photo size should be 4.5 cm × 3.5 cm.
- The photograph should contain the full name as per the passport of the student and the date it was taken on, at the bottom of the photo.
- Refer to the sample attached along with this circular.

CBSE offers two levels of Mathematics at the Class 10 Board Exam which has to be selected in grade 9:

Basic Mathematics -

- Easier level of questions.
- Suitable for students who do not wish to take Mathematics in higher classes (Grade 11 & 12) or in college courses that require Mathematics.
- Helpful for students who find Mathematics difficult and want to focus on other subjects.
- In college, students choosing Basic can go for general degree courses (Arts, Humanities, Commerce without Maths, etc., such as B.A., B.Com. (without Maths), BBA, etc.), but they cannot opt for Science with Mathematics or professional courses that require Maths in Grade 11 & 12.

Standard Mathematics -

- Regular level of questions.
- Required for students who plan to study Mathematics in Grade 11 & 12 (Science with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics or Commerce with Mathematics).
- Recommended for students who are confident and strong in Mathematics.



- In college, students choosing Standard can go for all degree options, including Science, Engineering, Commerce with Mathematics, and professional courses.

➤ **Important points to note:**

- The syllabus for Basic and Standard is the same. The only difference is in the difficulty level of the Board Exam paper.
- The choice is made in Grade 10, but we are sharing this information in Grade 9 so that parents and students can prepare well in advance.
- We encourage you to discuss with your child, observe their interest and performance in Mathematics, and guide them in making the right choice when the time comes.
