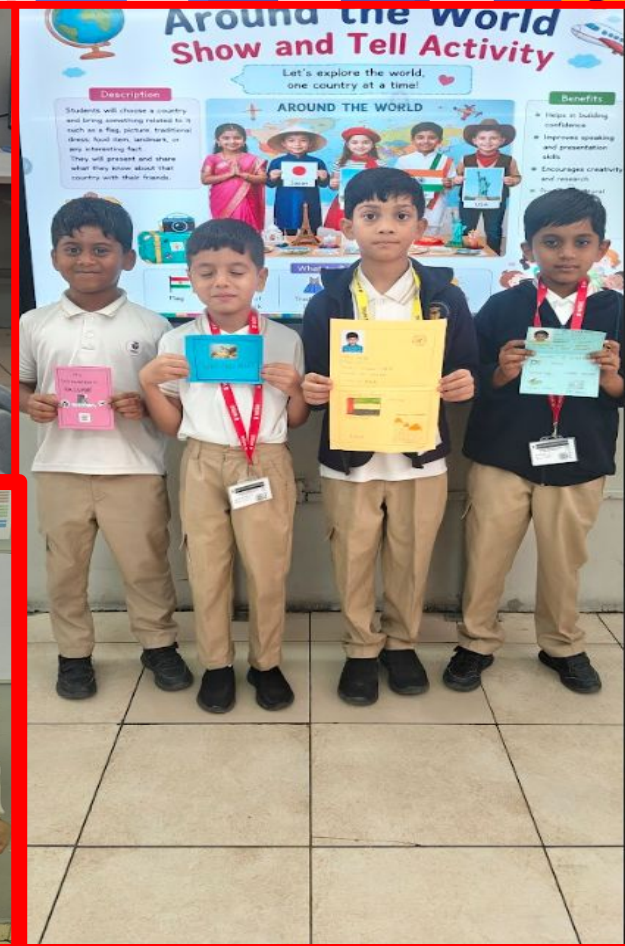
Around the world

5TH JUNE 2025



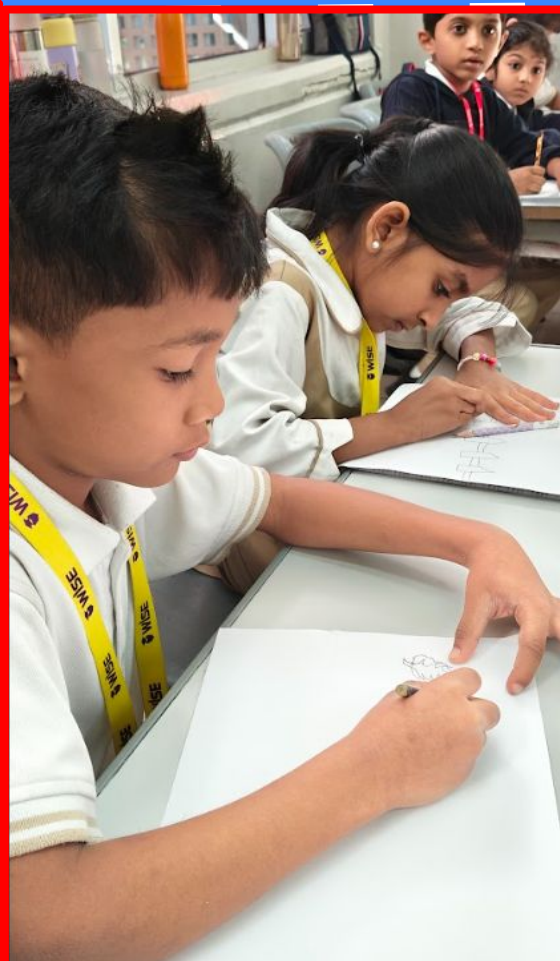

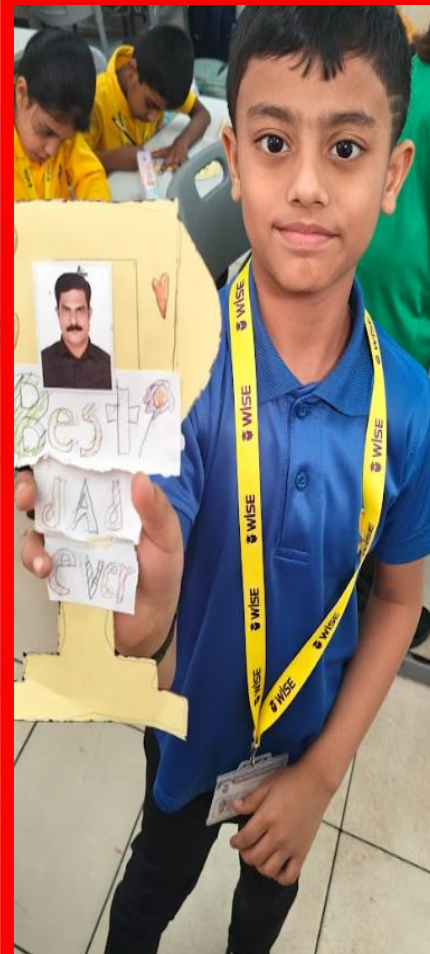
Our young learners celebrated **Father's Day** on 19th June with great enthusiasm and love. ★

Students may choose any one Hindi rhyme and recite it with correct pronunciation, appropriate voice modulation, confidence, and expressive actions.

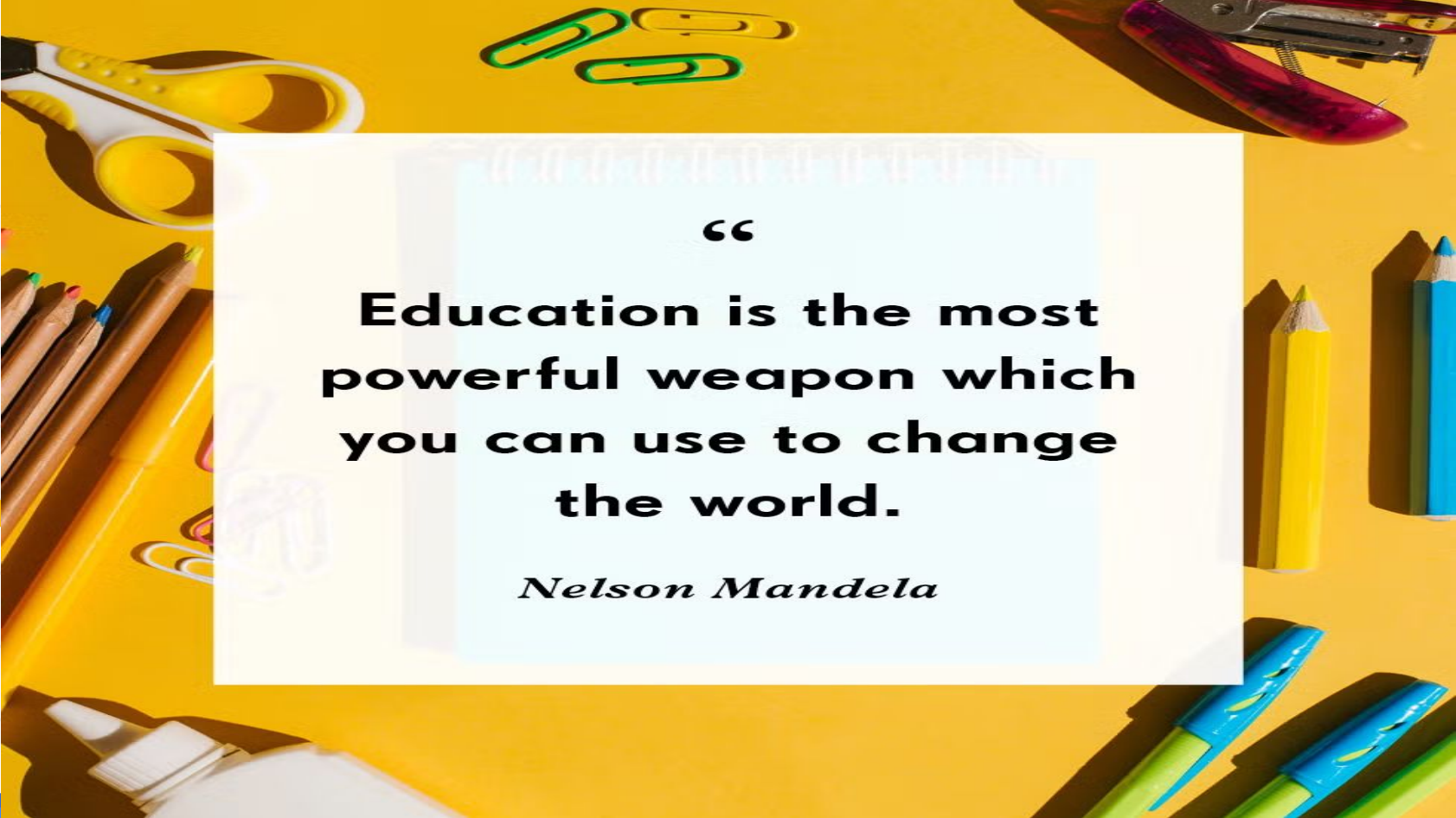
