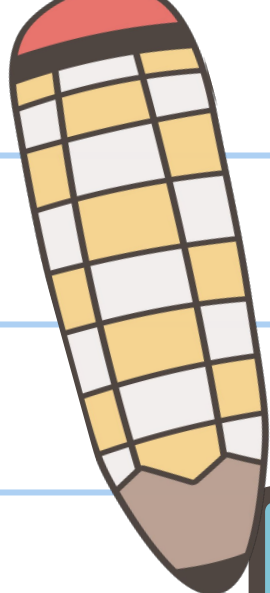

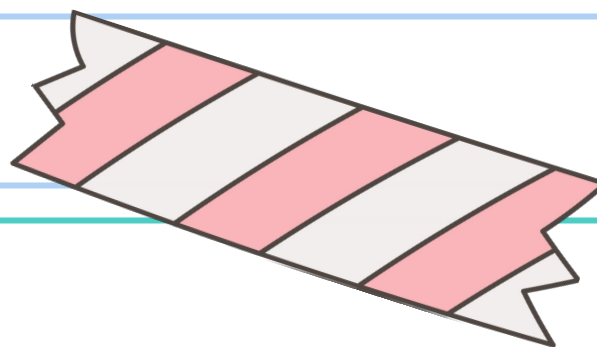

Every individual student is unique hence, we are committed to provide a stimulating and nurturing environment that will inspire and empower them to become more responsible, innovative, confident and well rounded.



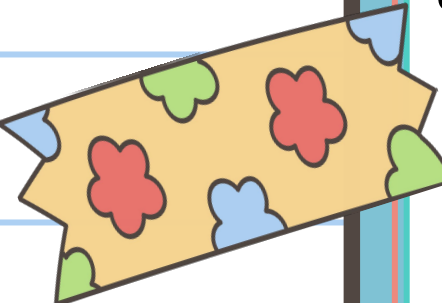
Welcome to Grade 1!

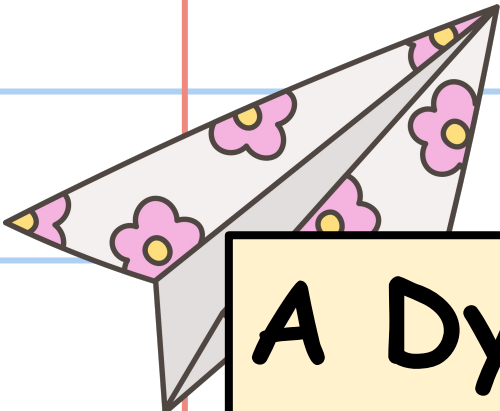

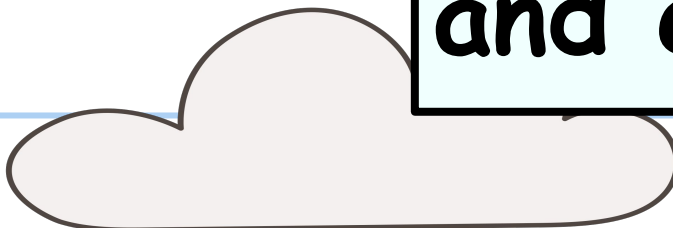


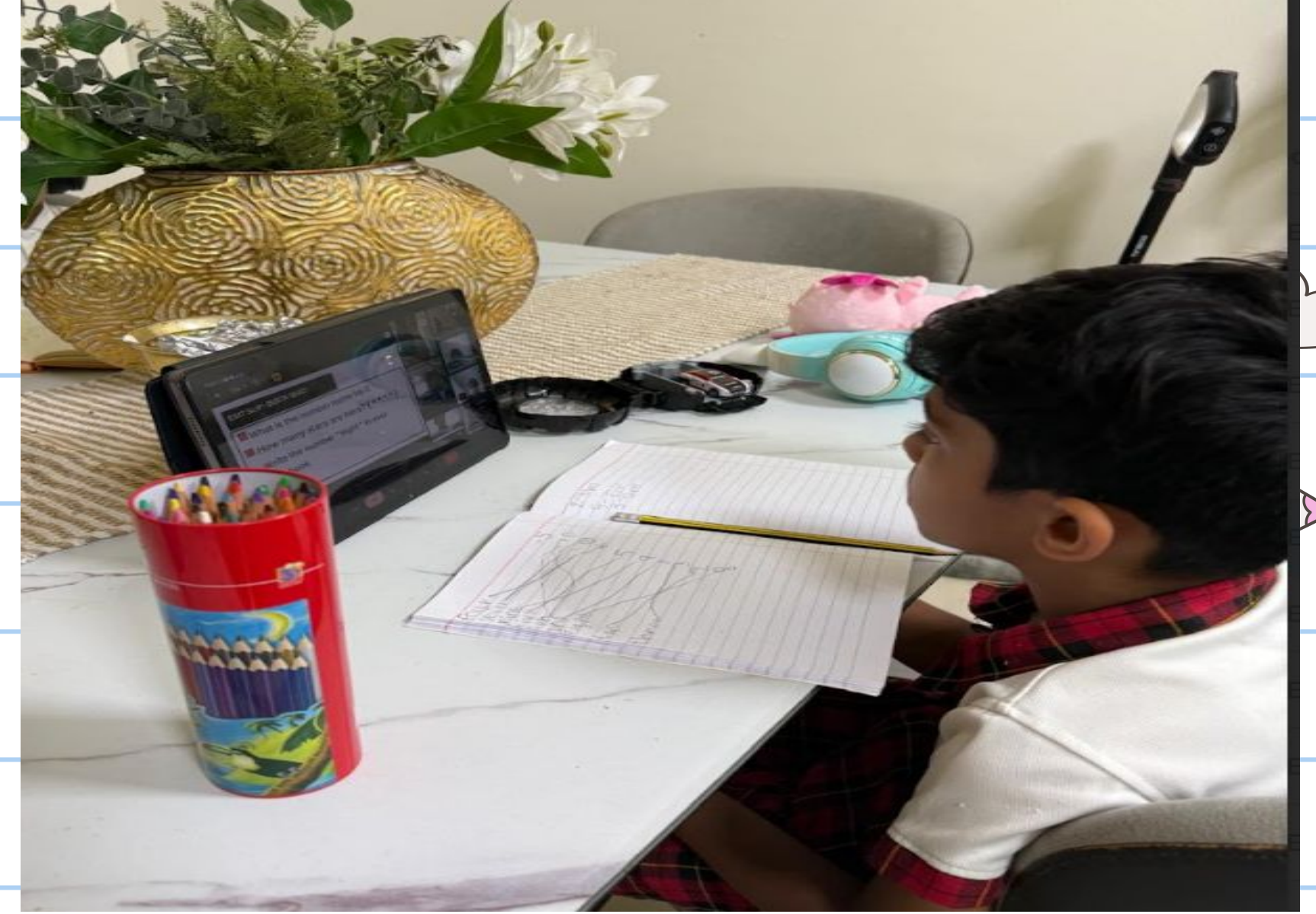


A Dynamic Start to Learning: Our Virtual Classroom Journey

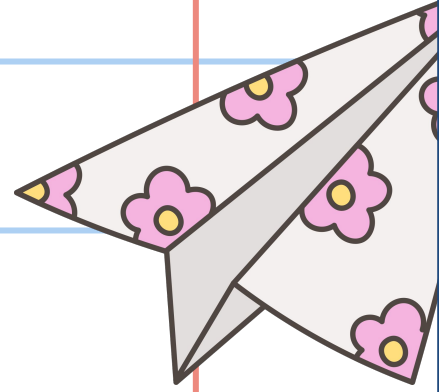


They also made beautiful hand cutouts. On each hand, they wrote slogans and drew pictures to show how they can protect the Earth. 🖐️ 🎨
