Activity	A short storytelling session was conducted in which the teacher narrated the story of Prophet Ibrahim (AS) and Prophet Ismail (AS) in simple words, helping students understand the significance of Eid. Grade 1 students participated in a creative craft activity where they coloured the Ka'ba, decorated sheep cut-outs with wool, and assembled their work on paper plates. The activity helped develop their creativity and fine motor skills while enhancing their understanding of Eid traditions. Grade 2 students enthusiastically took part in a card-making activity to celebrate Eid. They designed and decorated colourful greeting cards, expressing their festive spirit and creativity.
