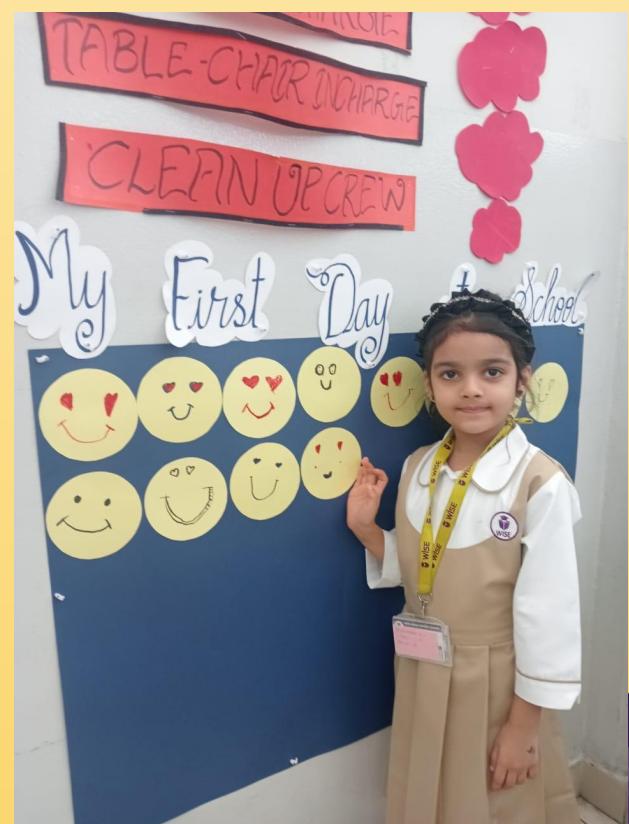
First day of school ...
