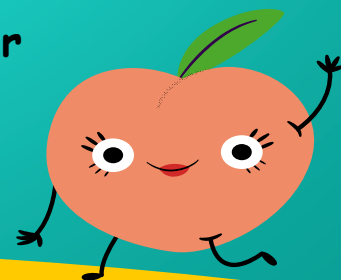
Glimpse of activities



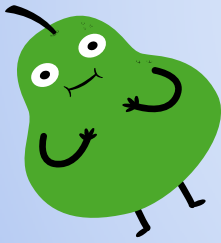
First day of school

Welcome Assembly



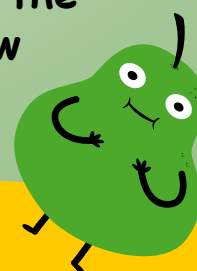
