COOKING WITHOUT FIRE



The classroom buzzed with excitement as students independently assembled their dishes, developing basic culinary skills and an understanding of food hygiene.


This hands-on experience fostered fine motor coordination, responsibility, and confidence, blending learning with fun in a truly memorable way.




