<b>Activity</b>	<p><b>Grade 1:</b> Grade 1 students enjoyed activities to strengthen their knowledge of Hindi letters. They began with a lively whole-class poem recitation, recorded and shared on Class Dojo. In groups, they then shaped Hindi letters with clay, promoting teamwork and neat letter formation. The best-performing group was appreciated for their effort.</p> <p><b>Grade 2:</b> Grade 2 students celebrated Hindi Diwas with activities to build their language and communication skills. They started with a joyful poem recitation, recorded and posted on Class Dojo. Next, after watching a story video, they worked in groups to recall, draw, and write names of objects and characters.
