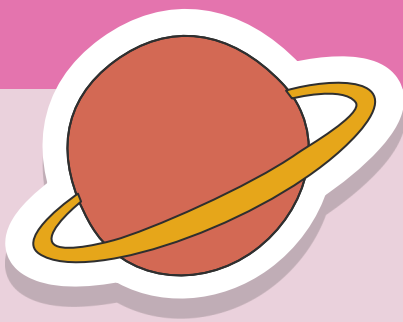

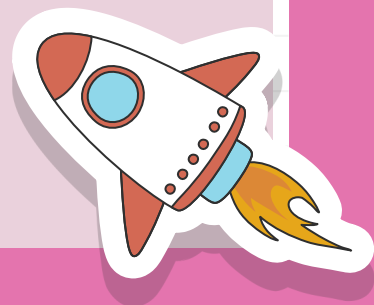

E-safety Awareness



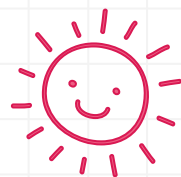

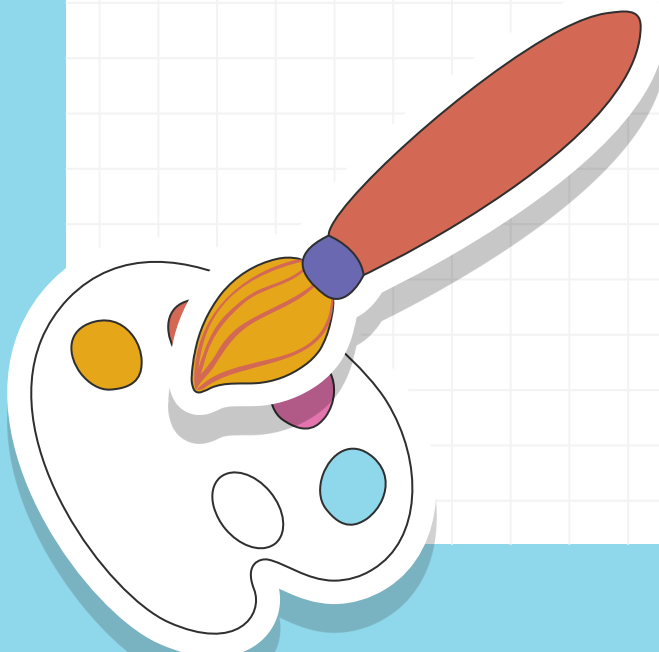


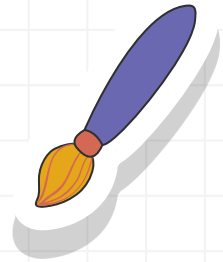
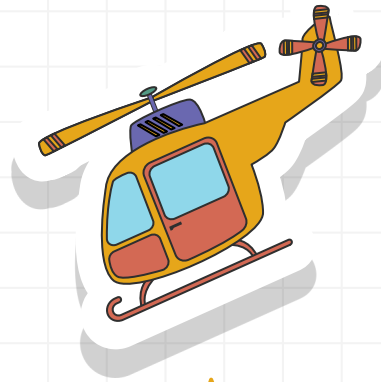
FRUIT KEBAB:
