

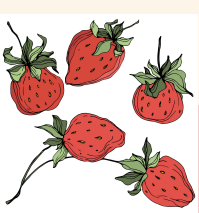
We also marked **International Plastic Free Day**, helping children understand the importance of protecting the environment through age-appropriate activities and discussions.

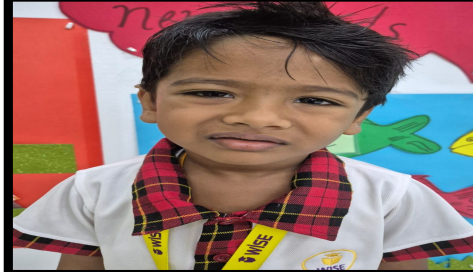

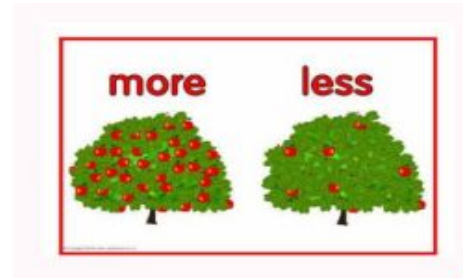
