


MISSION

Mother's day

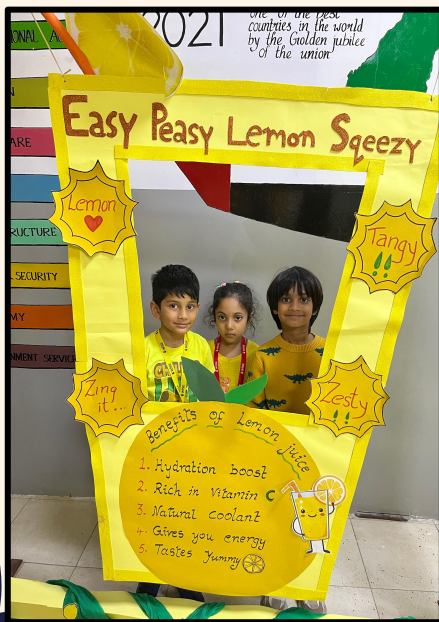
