Objectives	● To develop students' confidence and fluency in spontaneous public speaking. ● To enhance communication, critical thinking, and presentation skills through impromptu speech.
Outcome	● Students demonstrated improved confidence, clarity, and effective verbal communication while speaking before an audience. ● The activity encouraged independent thinking, quick organization of ideas, and greater participation in public speaking activities.

BRIEF REPORT

The English Department successfully conducted a JAM (Just A Minute) Activity for Grades 3 to 5 on Friday, 26th June 2026, during the second and third periods (Class Teacher period). The activity aimed to enhance students' confidence, communication skills, and spontaneous speaking abilities.

At the beginning of the session, grade-appropriate topics were displayed on the smartboard. Students were given 10 minutes to select a topic and organize their ideas before delivering a one-minute speech. They presented their thoughts without using any notes or written material, encouraging natural expression and quick thinking.

Teachers evaluated each participant using a scoring rubric based on content, fluency, confidence, pronunciation, and presentation skills. One outstanding speaker from each class was selected for recognition and will be awarded a certificate during the school assembly.

The activity witnessed enthusiastic participation, with students displaying creativity, confidence, and effective public speaking skills. It served as an engaging platform to nurture communication and critical thinking in a supportive learning environment.
