LEARNING OBJECTIVE:

To help children recognize traffic signs, signals, and crossings such as zebra crossings and traffic lights.

The KG1 and KG2 students participated in an exciting and educational event organized by the Health, Safety, and Environment (HSE) Department, led by Mr. Alston Lawrence. Held in the school auditorium, the session focused on road safety awareness and included a guided school bus tour.

Mr. Lawrence began with a warm welcome and an engaging presentation using colorful visuals and animations to teach basic road safety rules. Students learned how to cross roads safely, understand traffic signals, and the importance of seat belts.

A highlight was the live demonstration of a zebra crossing where children practiced the “Stop, Look, and Listen” rule with teacher guidance. This hands-on activity helped reinforce their understanding.

Later, the students enjoyed a supervised tour on a school bus. They learned how to enter, sit, and exit the bus safely. The children were enthusiastic and attentive, making the event both fun and educational.
