Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To familiarize students with basic road safety rules, including safe pedestrian crossing and bus safety.• To help students understand the correct way to ride a bicycle and the importance of wearing protective gear.• To promote awareness of danger zones around school buses and encourage responsible behavior near vehicles.

Activity	<p>The session on Road Safety was conducted for students of Grade 1 and 2 along with their teachers at the school auditorium. The program, organized by the HSE Department, began with an introductory note highlighting the importance of safe practices on the road.</p> <p>Using engaging visual aids and interactive discussions, students were taught the essentials of pedestrian crossing, recognizing road signs, bus safety, identifying danger zones around buses, the correct way to ride a bicycle, and the importance of wearing a helmet. They were also guided on the importance of wearing a seatbelt and the correct way to fasten it while travelling in a vehicle. The lively session encouraged children to adopt safe habits and become responsible road users.</p>
Learning outcome	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students were able to identify key road signs and explain the rules for safe walking and crossing.• They demonstrated an understanding of bus safety practices, including recognizing danger zones and importance of wearing seatbelt.• Students expressed the importance of using helmets and following safety measures while cycling.
